Combining various media and techniques, the notorious street-style works produced by Mr.

Brainwash incorporate themes of positivity and perseverance, and feature the imagery of celebrities, iconic brands, and the artist's trademark mottos.

"In terms of street art, Mr. Brainwash is as big as it gets," said Michael Bivins, "We think Dallas will really respond to his work."

Mr. Brainwash's distinctive graffiti-fusion style and his collaborations with celebrities have made his work highly sought after. From screen prints to stencils and spray paints, Mr. Brainwash's works of art are improvisational and dynamic. His art transmits his spirit and incredible positivity, and as Mr. Brainwash himself said, "It's the artwork, it's our life, we are the art in the end." Many of his works reflect the artist's outlook through his trademark phrase, "Life is Beautiful."
